

The Health Services Authority is responsible for the provision and administration of primary and secondary levels of healthcare services and public health functions for residents of the three Cayman Islands through a 127-bed hospital on Grand Cayman, a 18-bed hospital in Cayman Brac, satellite outpatient clinic in Little Cayman and four District Health Centers on Grand Cayman offering the most comprehensive range of inpatient and outpatient services in a single health system in the Cayman Islands.

The ENT Surgeon provides a quality patient centred ENT service at the Cayman Islands Hospital, Grand Cayman as well as a backup service for Faith Hospital, Cayman Brac. Work is generated by way of patient referrals from other consultants and the Accident and Emergency departments as well as private practitioners. The successful candidate is expected to also refer patients to other disciplines within the Cayman Islands Hospital as indicated by the clinical needs of the patients.

Primary Responsibilities include: The successful candidate is responsible for providing 24-hour ENT service in collaboration with one (1) full time staff and one (1) visiting ENT consultant. The candidate provides backup services to the Accident and Emergency department and involves colleagues from other disciplines where the clinical need is required in the management of patients. Also provides regular ENT surgical outpatient services and ward rounds including allergy clinics and hearing aid workshops on an agreed basis. Works in close liaison with the Anaesthetists and Operating Theatre nursing staff to ensure the efficient running of the operating schedule.

Qualification & Experience: The successful candidate must have a primary medical degree and specialist qualifications (i.e MB ChB and FRCS or MBBS and DM, ENT) qualifications or equivalent from a recognised institution and be eligible for registration with the Cayman Islands Health Practice Commission. The successful candidate must have a minimum of seven (7) years post graduate practical experience in the ENT specialty relevant to the services required. The ability to work well within a multidisciplinary team is essential.

A remuneration and benefit package, commensurate with experience and qualifications will be offered to the successful candidate.

Background Information

The Cayman Islands Health Services Authority ("HSA") provides and administers health care services and public health functions for residents of the Cayman Islands in accordance with the National Strategic Plan for Health.

Services are delivered primarily through the 127-beds at the Cayman Islands Hospital (the country's principal health care facility), and the 18-beds at the Faith Hospital on Cayman Brac. Ancillary services are offered at district health centres, and clinics for dental and ophthalmologic care. Residents of Little Cayman can access care through the island's clinic which is a purpose-built facility.

Job purpose

To provide a quality patient centered ENT service at the Cayman Islands Hospital, Grand Cayman, and a backup service for the Faith Hospital.

Work is generated by patients referred by other consultants and the Accident and Emergency Departments. Patients transferred from General Practice Clinics. Patients referred from private practitioners.

Post holder is expected to refer patients to other disciplines within the government health service, or to tertiary center, where this is indicated by the clinical needs of the patients.

Liaise closely with colleagues in other clinical disciplines.

Dimensions

The principal specialties are provided by the C.I. Health Service Authority. Those requiring tertiary referral to Miami include neurosurgery, specialist pediatric surgery, thoracic and vascular surgery, with some requiring air ambulance transfer. The 8 CCU beds enable more critically ill patients to be retained on the island.

There are two trauma resuscitation rooms in the Accident & Emergency Department.

Postholder has no budgetary responsibilities

Provide ENT back up for the Faith Hospital.

Duties and responsibilities

To provide a 24-hour ENT service.

To provide regular ENT surgical outpatient clinics and ward rounds on an agreed basis.

To provide back-up for the accident and emergency medical staff

To provide allergy clinics on an agreed basis

To provide hearing aid workshop

To involve colleagues in other disciplines, where this is indicated by clinical need, and work in close cooperation with them in the management of patients.

To work in close liaison, with the anaesthetists and operating theatre nursing staff to ensure the efficient running of the operating schedules

To take part in continuing professional development for medical staff

To run outpatient clinics at Faith Hospital from time as a backup.

To be available in times of national disaster

To participate in strategic healthcare planning of medical services

To establish, with colleagues, an ongoing education program for nursing and other staff within the department

Must have a MB ChB and FRCS or equivalent. recognized in the Cayman Islands

At least 7 years postgraduate experience in the specialty relevant to the services provided

Eligible for registration with the Health Practice Commission

Postholder may be involved in the supervision and training of returning Caymanian Doctors who are employed in the Department.

Postholder guides the nursing staff in the care of the ENT patients.
