PHYSIOTHERAPIST

Salary range: CI\$75,228 – CI\$101,160 per annum

Primary Responsibilities: The Physiotherapist is responsible for assessing, treating, and rehabilitating patients with musculoskeletal, neurological, and other physical conditions to restore function, relieve pain, improve mobility, and prevent disability. Working across inpatient and outpatient settings, the successful candidate will manage a diverse caseload using evidence-based physiotherapy practices, develop individualized treatment plans, monitor patient progress, and collaborate with multidisciplinary teams to deliver high-quality, patient-centred care.

Qualifications and Experience: The successful candidate must possess a Bachelor's degree in Physiotherapy and a minimum of three (3) years' post-qualification clinical experience managing a broad range of musculoskeletal, neurological, and rehabilitation cases. Eligibility for registration to practice in the Cayman Islands is required, together with a current license to practice in Canada, South Africa, the United Kingdom, the United States, Jamaica, or New Zealand. The candidate should demonstrate sound clinical judgement, strong assessment and treatment skills, and experience applying evidence-based physiotherapy interventions, including therapeutic exercise, manual therapy, electro-physical modalities, movement re-education, and orthotic or prosthetic management. Excellent interpersonal, written, and verbal communication skills, proficiency in Microsoft Office applications, and the ability to work effectively within a multidisciplinary team are essential. A valid driver's license is desirable.

A remuneration and benefits package, commensurate with experience and qualifications will be offered to the successful candidate.

Background Information

The Cayman Islands Health Services Authority (“HSA”) provides and administers health care services and public health functions for residents of the Cayman Islands in accordance with the National Strategic Plan for Health.

Services are delivered primarily through the 127-beds at the Cayman Islands Hospital (the country’s principal health care facility), and the 18-beds at the Faith Hospital on Cayman Brac. Ancillary services are offered at district health centres, and clinics for dental and ophthalmologic care. Residents of Little Cayman can access care through the island’s clinic which is a purpose-built facility.

This position plays a key role in providing medical care to those presenting with neuro-musculoskeletal and respiratory problems.

Job purpose

Restores patient's function, alleviates pain, and prevents disabilities by planning and administering physiotherapy treatments.

Dimensions

- Postholder will manage a monthly caseload of approximately 45 patients at 160 visits; based on case/patient complexity.
- Postholder has no budgetary responsibility.
- Postholder does not supervise any other staff.
- Postholder may from time to time act as clinical supervisors to Physiotherapy students undergoing clinical rotations.

Duties and responsibilities

- Meets the patient's goals and needs and provides quality care by assessing and interpreting evaluations and test results, determining physical therapy treatment plans through independent judgement and in consultation with physicians or by prescription.
- Helps patient accomplish treatment plan and accept therapeutic devices by administering manual exercises; instructing, encouraging, and assisting patients in performing physical activities, such as exercises, ambulatory functional activities, and daily-living activities and in using assistive and supportive devices, such as crutches, canes, and prostheses.
- Communicate and coordinate with patients’ physicians to ensure a consistent level of care
- Administers physical therapy treatments through exercise prescription and the use of electro-therapeutic modalities.
- Evaluates the effects of physical therapy treatments and fit of prosthetic and orthotic devices by observing, noting, and evaluating patient's progress, recommending adjustments and modifications.
- Completes discharge planning by consulting with physicians, nurses, social workers, and other health care workers, contributing to patient care conferences.

- Assures continuation of therapeutic plan following discharge by designing home exercise programs; instructing patients, families, and caregivers in home exercise programs; recommending and/or providing assistive equipment; recommending outpatient or home health follow-up programs.
- Documents patient care services by charting in patient records.
- Maintains patient confidence and protects hospital operations by keeping information confidential.
- Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
- Protects patients and employees by adhering to infection-control policies and protocols.
- Ensures operation of equipment by following manufacturer's instructions; troubleshooting malfunctions; calling for repairs.
- Maintains professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications; establishing personal networks; participating in professional societies.
- Develops physical therapy staff by providing information, developing and conducting in-service training programs.

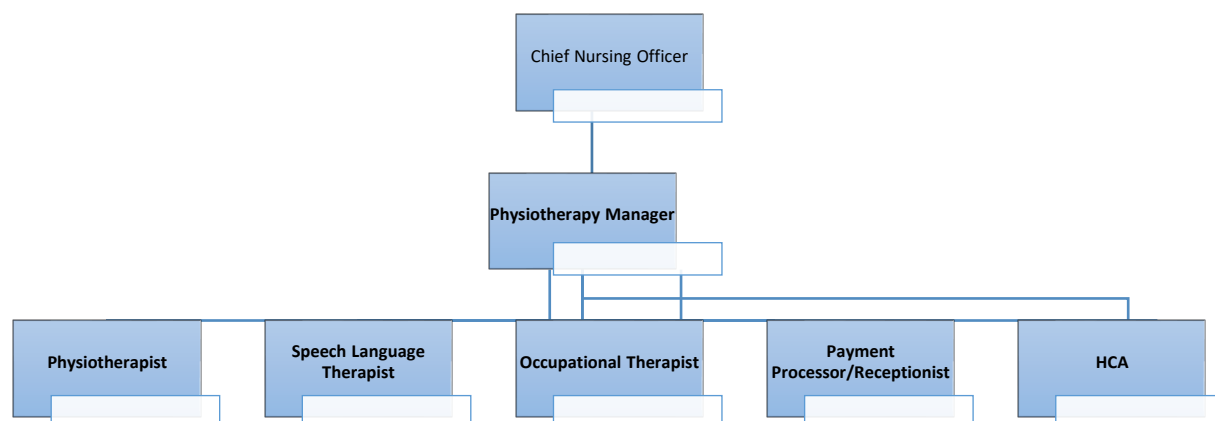
- BSc. in Physiotherapy or the equivalent.

Decision Making Authority and Controls

Working conditions

The post holder is required to work a 37.5-hour week and rostered weekends where he/she is on-call. Work location will be the In-patient Wards, the out- patient department, patient homes and other community sites.

Physical requirements

The job can be physically demanding because therapists often have to stoop, kneel, crouch, lift, and stand for long periods. In addition, physical therapists move heavy equipment and lift patients or help them turn, stand, or walk.
