PHYSIOTHERAPIST (FAITH HOSPITAL)

The Physiotherapist restores patient's function, alleviates pain, and prevents disabilities by planning and administering physiotherapy treatments.

Primary Responsibilities: The successful candidate will deliver high-quality, patient-centred care, help individuals meet their recovery goals and improve their physical function. Using independent clinical judgment—guided by evaluations, test findings, and physician collaboration—the candidate will design and implement personalized treatment plans. He/she will perform therapeutic interventions, including manual exercises and fitting prosthetic or orthotic devices, and closely monitor progress to refine care as needed. A key part of this role will be coaching and motivating patients through exercises, daily-activity training, and use of assistive equipment like crutches, canes, or prostheses. You will also maintain seamless communication with physicians and care teams, ensure precise documentation of patient treatment and progress, and uphold the highest standards of confidentiality and professionalism.

Qualifications and Experience: The successful candidate will have a Bachelor of Science degree in Physiotherapy and a minimum of three (3) years of postgraduate experience. The candidate must be eligible for registration to practice in the Cayman Islands and hold a valid license to practice in either, Canada, South Africa, UK, USA, Jamaica, Australia or New Zealand. A valid driver's license is desirable. Proficiency in the use of Microsoft Office and excellent written and oral communication is essential.

A remuneration and benefits package, commensurate with experience and qualifications will be offered to the successful candidate.

Background Information

The Cayman Islands Health Services Authority ("HSA") provides and administers health care services and public health functions for residents of the Cayman Islands in accordance with the National Strategic Plan for Health.

Services are delivered primarily through the 127-beds at the Cayman Islands Hospital (the country's principal health care facility), and the 18-beds at the Faith Hospital on Cayman Brac. Ancillary services are offered at district health centres, and clinics for dental and ophthalmologic care. Residents of Little Cayman can access care through the island's clinic which is a purpose-built facility.

This position plays a key role in providing medical care to those presenting with neuro-musculoskeletal and respiratory problems.

Job purpose

Restores patient's function, alleviates pain, and prevents disabilities by planning and administering physiotherapy treatments.

Dimensions

The post holder does not supervise any other staff.

Postholders have no budgetary responsibility.

Duties and responsibilities

- ☐ Meets the patient's goals and needs and provides quality care by assessing and interpreting evaluations and test results, determining physical therapy treatment plans through independent judgement and in consultation with physicians or by prescription.
- ☐ Helps patient accomplish treatment plan and accept therapeutic devices by administering manual exercises, instructing, encouraging, and assisting patients in performing physical activities, such as exercises, ambulatory functional activities, and daily living activities and in using assistive and supportive devices, such as crutches, canes, and prostheses.
- ☐ Communicate and coordinate with patients' physicians to ensure a consistent level of care.
- ☐ Administers physical therapy treatments through exercise prescription and the use of thermal and electro-therapeutic modalities.
- ☐ Evaluates effects of physical therapy treatments and fit of prosthetic and orthotic devices by observing, noting, and evaluating patient's progress, recommending adjustments and modifications.
- ☐ Completes discharge planning by consulting with physicians, nurses, social workers, and other health care workers; contributing to patient care conferences.

- ☐ Assures continuation of therapeutic plan following discharge by designing home exercise programs; instructing patients, families, and caregivers in home exercise programs; recommending and/or providing assistive equipment; recommending outpatient or home health follow-up programs.
- ☐ Documents patient care services by charting in patient records.
- ☐ Maintains patient confidence and protects hospital operations by keeping information confidential.
- ☐ Maintains safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
- ☐ Protects patients and employees by adhering to infection-control policies and protocols.
- ☐ Ensures operation of equipment by following manufacturer's instructions; troubleshooting malfunctions; calling for repairs.
- ☐ Maintains professional and technical knowledge by attending educational workshops; reviewing professional publications; establishing personal networks; participating in professional societies.
- ☐ Prepare and conduct patient handling techniques with healthcare workers.

Staff Management

Supervise student interns when necessary.

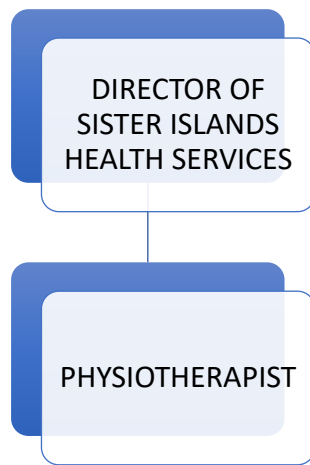

Working conditions

The post holder is required to work a 37.5-hour week as well as weekends on-call and standby duties when necessary. Work location will be the In-patient Wards, the out-patient department, patient homes and other community sites.

Physical requirements

The job can be physically demanding because therapists often have to stoop, kneel, crouch, lift, and stand for long periods. In addition, physical therapists move heavy equipment and lift patients or help them turn, stand, or walk.

Problem/Key Features

Post holder along with another Physiotherapist is the provider of the service on the island and as such must always be prepared to do on call, standby and weekend duties when necessary.
