RADIOLOGIST (Interventional)

Job Summary: The successful candidate will provide comprehensive diagnostic and interventional radiology services at the Cayman Islands Hospital and Faith Hospital as required. The role includes performing and interpreting a wide range of imaging investigations, undertaking specialized interventional procedures, overseeing imaging services, ensuring compliance with radiation safety standards, supporting strategic healthcare planning, and collaborating with multidisciplinary teams to deliver high-quality, patient-centred care. The postholder will also participate in clinical audits, continuing medical education, staff development, and support compliance with Joint Commission International (JCI) standards and accreditation requirements.

Qualifications and Experience: The successful candidate must possess a Medical Degree together with a postgraduate qualification such as an MD and a super-specialist qualification in Interventional Radiology, such as a DM or Fellowship. Applicants must have a minimum of five (5) years of postgraduate experience in the specialty, including substantial experience in interventional vascular and endovascular techniques. Candidates must be eligible for specialist registration with the Cayman Islands Medical and Dental Council and demonstrate expertise in CT, MRI, mammography, and ultrasound imaging. Strong clinical, leadership, communication, and multidisciplinary collaboration skills are essential.

A remuneration and benefits package, commensurate with experience and qualifications will be offered to the successful candidate.

Background Information

The Cayman Islands Health Services Authority (“HSA”) provides and administers health care services and public health functions for residents of the Cayman Islands in accordance with the National Strategic Plan for Health.

Services are delivered primarily through the 136-beds at the Cayman Islands Hospital (the country’s principal health care facility), and the 18-beds at the Faith Hospital on Cayman Brac. Ancillary services are offered at district health centres, and clinics for dental and ophthalmologic care. Residents of Little Cayman can access care through the island’s clinic which is a purpose-built facility.

Job purpose

To provide a high-quality patient centered radiology service at the Cayman Islands Hospital, Grand Cayman, and Faith Hospital when necessary.

To provide specialized radiological and other imaging procedures and interpret and report on all investigations carried out.

To advise on all imaging equipment in the Health Services Department

To provide consultative advice to allied medical and surgical specialties.

Dimensions

The principal specialties are provided by the Health Services Authority. Those requiring tertiary referral to Miami include neurosurgery, specialist pediatric surgery, thoracic and vascular surgery, with some requiring air ambulance transfer. The 8 CCU beds, in the new hospital, now enable more critically ill patients to be retained on the island.

The postholder has no budgetary responsibilities.

Duties and responsibilities

To provide a 24-hour imaging service

To undertake specialist investigations

Interpret and report on imaging investigations.

To have oversight of the service of Faith Hospital

To manage the imaging Service effectively and efficiently within the resources available

To take part in continuing professional development for medical staff including clinical audit and clinico-radiological meetings

To ensure that agreed radiation and other safety standards are maintained.

To be available in times of national disaster

To participate in strategic healthcare planning of medical service

To establish, with colleagues, an ongoing education program for radiographers and other staff within the department

Qualifications, Experience & Skills Requirement

- Must have a Medical Degree and postgraduate qualifications such as MD along with super-specialist qualifications like DM or Fellowship.
- At least 5 years postgraduate experience in the specialty and substantial experience in interventional vascular surgical and endovascular techniques.
- Be eligible for specialist registration in the Cayman Islands with the C.I. Medical and Dental Council.
- Should have specific experience in CT, MRI, mammography and ultrasound
